### Board of Directors

 Sept. 2nd<sup>h</sup> General Partnership Annual Meeting (in the Field House). It is during this meeting that the Board of Directors Elections will take place. Any Volunteer who passed through the CORI process during 2008 is eligible to vote.

### Registration

**Junior and Major (A) League: Due at time of tryout or the last scheduled rain make-up\* for tryouts.**

September 14<sup>th</sup> Registration Cut-off for 2009, Minor League  
 Feb. 15<sup>th</sup> (2009) Registration Cut-off for 2009, Instructional and Tee-Ball Divisions

**If mailed, registration form must be post marked prior to the deadline above.**

### Managers Letters of Intention

Managers must submit a request to Manage a team during 2009 in writing (e-mail is acceptable) prior to the September 2nd General Partnership Meeting. Managers will be voted in during the September 4<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting.

### Tryouts for Junior & Major (A) League

**Sunday**, September 14<sup>th</sup> - 10 AM to 12 Noon & **Saturday**, September 21st – 12 PM – 2 PM

**Rain Dates: Sunday**, September 20<sup>th</sup> - 10 AM to 12 Noon & **Saturday**, September 28<sup>th</sup> – 12 PM – 2 PM

Players will not be allowed to try-out without first completing a registration form, with proof of residency and paying in full.

**Any player who does not attend at least one of the try-out sessions will not be allowed to enter the draft (will not play in 2009). Exceptions to this rule (for Medical or any other valid reason) must be cleared by the Board of Directors during the September 4<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting (i.e. PRIOR to the Tryout date).**

### Volunteers

As you know, Fairhaven Little League is a Volunteer organization. We need a lot of help to keep the program running smoothly and make improvements at the same time. In addition to the Managers and Coaches you see working with the players, we need the help of many others each year. If you are willing to donate some of your time, we would greatly appreciate it. In addition, if you have a special talent or skill (like being a carpenter, electrician, painter, etc) we may be able to utilize your skills working in that capacity. We are planning several off-season projects that could use trades people and we could use a lot of Field Maintenance help throughout the regular season. Please consider volunteering, even if for only a limited time.

Also, please consider that most of the work that the Board and the special committees undertake is done during the off-season. Planning for Fund-Raisers, uniform orders, special projects, etc. will all take place between September and March. Once the season starts everyone is consumed with ongoing league activities and special projects and improvements slow to a crawl. So if you are available through the winter to work on one of our special committees please let us know. For all of those who have done so in 2007 and prior years, thanks for your support, you really make the difference in our league.

We are also looking to form a few special committees from people outside of the board to study things like the All-Star selection process, training for our players, Code of Conduct policies, etc. These groups of 6-8 people would meet once per week for about 6 weeks and come up with recommendations to the board. We hope that additional support from people outside the board will really help get things done and we think that it will be good to solicit opinions from outside the board for reference. If you are interested in these areas or would like to head up a group to review something else, please let us know. If you have any other comments or suggestions for the league feel free to attach them on a separate piece of paper or send them in anonymously. Your input is very important to the Board of Directors when it comes time to make key decisions like who should be voted in for Manager and Coach openings (**September 6<sup>th</sup>**), which improvement projects and fund raisers we should focus on, how All-Stars should be selected, length of season, season start and end date, umpire issues, code of conduct issues, etc. Now is your opportunity to have a positive influence on the league for next year.
